NO THANKS TO:

- Coffee bags and chips bags (leave in household waste)
- Spray cans and packaging from chemicals, etc. (in the red recycling container)
- Rainwear and rubber boots (at the recycling centre)
- Electronics and cables (at the recycling centre)



YES TO:

- Newspapers, advertisements and magazines
- Envelopes
- Egg boxes
- Breakfast cereal containers and the like
- Cardboard tubes from toilet paper rolls/kitchen towel rolls

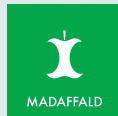
SHOULD NOT BE DISPOSED OF IN BAGS



Must be dry and clean.

NO THANKS TO:

- Large cardboard (at the recycling centre)
- Pizza trays (in household waste)
- Milk and juice cartons (in household waste)
- Paper with leftover food (in household waste)
- Wrapping paper (in household waste)



YES TO:

- Food leftovers
- Raw food
- Meat and bone
- Vegetables
- Eggs
- Bread
- Cut flowers

SHOULD BE DISPOSED IN THE GREEN BAGS. SEAL WITH A KNOT



Must not contain packaging.

NO THANKS TO:

- in a sealed bag)
- Diapers (in household waste)
- Kitty litter and pet waste (in household waste)
- Garden waste and soil (at the recycling centre)



YES TO:

- Waste you are uncertain about
- Pizza boxes
- Milk and juice cartons
- Expanded polystyrene, e.g. styrofoam
- Diapers
- Ash (cold and in a bag)
- Vacuum cleaner bags
- Kitty litter and pet waste

SHOULD BE DISPOSED IN SEALED BAGS



NO THANKS TO:

- Hazardous waste (in the red recycling container)



YES TO:

- Glass bottles regardless of colour (e.g. ketchup, dressing, soft drink, liquor and wine bottles)
- Glass jars for preserves (e.g. jars that contained mustard, beets, herring and jam), preferably with the lid
- Jam jars
- Drinking glasses, etc.

SHOULD NOT BE DISPOSED OF IN BAGS



NO THANKS TO:

- Energy-saving light bulbs
- Bottles and glass with contents still inside them
- Pottery/ceramics
- Medicine glasses, empty
- Porcelain
- Window glass
- Tempered glass
- Ovenproof/fireproof glass
